








If you are unsure about installing this product or the setup of your projector we recommend installation by a professional AV installer.

The Skyhook Direct to Ceiling and Adjustable Post are packaged partially assembled. Some disassembly and re-assembly is required to install these products.

Installing the Direct to Ceiling Mount to the ceiling



Secure the ceiling mount assembly to the ceiling; A Slab Ring is provided if mounting a Skyhook to a concrete slab or ceiling. It allows cables to enter the mount and is spaced between the ceiling and the mount plate before fixing.



The Extended U-Hook, at the lower part of the assembly allows cable clearance



The Skyhook Post can be set to suit different ceiling angles.


Remove the ceiling plate from the post before attaching the plate to the ceiling.

A Slab Ring is provided if mounting a Skyhook to a concrete slab or ceiling. It allows cables to enter the mount and is spaced between the ceiling and the mount plate before fixing.


Re-assemble the post and hang the Skyhook at the desired angle.

Feed cables through the Skyhook post. Thin cables may be passed through the two side channels. It is recommended that the power and AV cables be separated to avoid interference.

Fit Cover Strips to complete the assembly








Flat ceiling mount

Beam or wall mount.




Above ceiling mount with 65mm hole in ceiling



Angled ceiling mount



Attach the Projector to the Skyhook (Arms).



Loosen the centre nut of the Projector mounting assembly and spread the mounting arms.

Mount the inverted projector to the arms using the set screws, washers and springs provided.

Adjust the arms and locate the Extended U-hook into the centre of the projector; tighten the

bolt and set screws to secure the projector.

Note: Do not over tighten the set screws. If your projector has only three mounting points remove and discard one arm. Reposition the U-hook to the centre of the projector.

On both sides of the square knuckle, loosen the top screw. Remove, but retain the second lower adjustment screw.


Hang the projector assembly U-hook over the top screw and reinsert the lower adjustment screw.





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Align the projector by partially loosening screws; then adjust the pan, tilt and yaw before tightening screws once more













Skyhook Direct to Ceiling Mount

Cut the Ceiling trim through the end of the trim where the internal web is missing.

Open up the trim into a "C" shape and place around the Direct to Ceiling mount.



Skyhook Adjustable Mount



Use the trim on a Skyhook Adjustable post, by sliding the trim down or along the tube to gain access to fixing and adjustment screws. It is only suitable for flat ceilings and above ceiling mounts.



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
